Women & Girls

Women and girls continue to be disproportionately affected by HIV, TB and malaria.

In sub-Saharan Africa, adolescent girls account for more than 25% of HIV infections, despite making up only 10% of the population. They are more than twice as likely to acquire HIV than their male peers.

While TB generally strikes more men than women, it remains among the top five causes of death for women between age 15 and 44 in low- and middle-income countries.

As for malaria, pregnant women are particularly susceptible to the disease.

Malaria is potentially fatal for the woman. It can cause miscarriage, low birth weight or premature births.

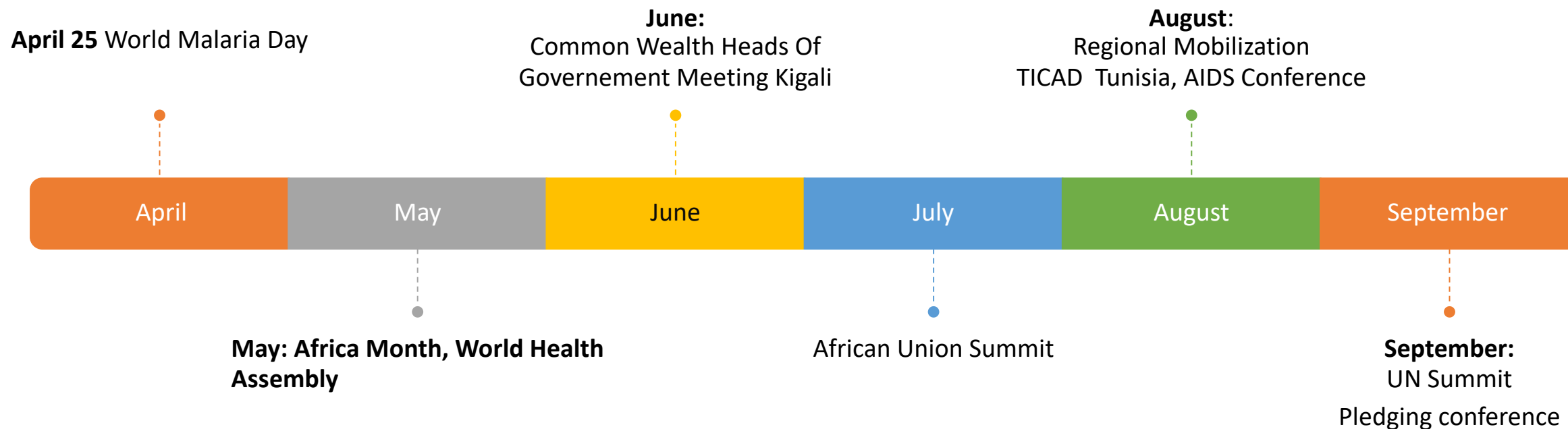
